

Nantucket Community Pool - Standard Operating Procedures for Reopen of Lap Swimming.
Effective July 6, 2020

PPE Requirements:

- All swimmers will wear masks entering and exiting the facility and on deck.
 - Masks will be removed prior to entering the water and placed back on once the swimmer has exited the water.

Physical Distancing Requirements:

- Swimmers must maintain at least 6 feet apart from those they don't live with.
 - There will be markings on the pool deck and visual cues to assist swimmers as they enter and exit the facility.
 - There will be designated areas for swimmers personal belongings based on what lane they are using.

Facility Procedures:

- All Membership and Day Pass rates apply in order to access the Pool. Memberships must be in good standing.
- An online sign up will be implemented to access Lap Swimming time blocks
 - Swimmers should sign up prior to coming to the facility. Dates will be open for registration 7-days out.
 - Swimmers will only be allowed to sign up for 1 block a day.
 - Each block will initially be 50-minutes long, allowing 10 minutes passing and cleaning time between blocks.
- There will be a one-way entrance and a one-way exit.
- Boy's and Girl's locker rooms will be closed. The Men's and Women's locker room will be limited to restroom use and showers only. There is no changing on site.
- The facility will be cleaned daily.

Self Screening Procedures:

- If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms, please stay at or be in contact with your physician
 - Fever, Shortness of breath, Cough, Chills, Muscle pain, Headache, Sore throat, New loss of taste or smell
 - Caring for someone who is ill.
 - Have had contact with someone who is diagnosed with COVID-19 or suspected of having COVID-19

Swimmer Protocol:

- Swimmers must arrive and depart in their swimsuit.
 - Swimmers will not be able to change at the facility.
- Swimmers will only be permitted to enter the facility once the time block before them have cleared the facility.
 - If swimmers arrive early, they should wait in their car or outside the facility while practicing physical distancing guidelines. There are markings 6 ft apart on the sidewalk to form a waiting line.
 - Swimmers must leave the facility immediately at the completion of their time block.
- Spectators will not be allowed in the facility at any time and are expected to practice physical distancing while waiting outside the facility.
- Swimmers should bring their own water bottle (already filled) and any other equipment they desire. Swimmers will not be permitted to store their equipment or any personal belongings at the facility.
- Criteria that must be met by athletes and anyone residing in their household in order to be eligible to attend practice:
 - Cannot have had contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
 - Cannot have had a temperature over 100.4 degrees, a cough or difficulty breathing in the last 14 days.
 - Cannot have traveled from out of state in the last 14 days. The exempt states are as follows: Maine, Vermont, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, Connecticut, New York and New Jersey.
- Any swimmer experiencing any symptoms of a fever, recent cough, unusual fatigue, headache or has had any exposure to someone who has any symptoms should remain at home and seek medical treatment.
 - If any swimmer has a fever or symptoms of illnesses, they may not use the facility until 14 days after the fever or symptoms have ceased.
 - Swimmers must see a physician and be medically cleared to use the facility after being diagnosed or suspected to have COVID-19.
- For us all to stay healthy and be able to keep swimming, we ask our swimmers to please practice responsible physical distancing when they are away from the pool as well.
- Should we feel anyone is consistently not adhering to physical distancing guidelines, their participation at the Nantucket Community Pool may be suspended.

Positive COVID-19 test procedure:

- Should someone test positive for COVID-19, the following measures must take place:
 - The individual should let the staff know immediately.
 - The facility will be shut down for no less than 24 hours to deep clean.
