The Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV) awards Junior Operator Licenses to drivers between the ages of 16 1/2 and 18.

To obtain a Junior Operator License, teens have to graduate from a state-approved driver's education school with:

- 30 hours of classroom instruction (15 topics + a written exam)
- 12 hours behind the wheel
- 6 hours of observation from the back seat of the training vehicle.

In addition, a parent or guardian must attend a two hour driver's education class.

NCS provides these requirements.

PARENTS TRAINING
